Step away from the demands and distractions of the 'real world' as you make time for your writing... and yourself! Take inspiration from history and culture, and from other writers, as you join us for our 13th Creative Writing Retreat... and the second to be held in York, England.

It's possible to write anywhere, of course, but the pleasure of writing on a retreat lies in combining creative pursuits with the discovery of new friends, new places and new experiences. York is a spectacular city in the North East of England founded by the Romans in 71AD. It has a long and fascinating history, and a wealth of intriguing buildings and attractions to explore. Walk the city walls, the oldest and best preserved in England. Wonder at York Minster, the spectacular cathedral built between 1220-1472, or visit Roman remains in the Undercroft. Travel back to Viking times at the interactive Jorvik Museum. Visit 'The Shambles', one of the best preserved medieval streets in Europe, and the inspiration for Diagon Alley in Harry





Potter.

York also offers world class shopping, a wealth of atmospheric old pubs, lovely

gardens, art galleries, museums, theatres, ghost tours and pleasure cruises down the River Ouse. Oh – and there's a writing festival in York while we're there!

Joining our creative writing retreat in York will give you the opportunity to explore an incredible city, while immersing yourself in your writing, and gaining inspiration from daily writing workshops.

Sightseeing

You may choose to focus on your writing in the afternoon, but we will also be offering two optional half day sightseeing trips. The first will be to Robin Hood's Bay, a beautiful and historic seaside town with lovely craft shops and stunning views. From there, writers will have the option of walking across the cliffs into Whitby, weather permitting. Our second half day trip will be to the spectacular house and gardens of Castle Howard, Located just outside York in the gorgeous Yorkshire countryside.

Since our retreat is not a package tour, writers always have the option either of joining us for these short excursions, or remaining in York to write or explore.

The Tower Guesthouse

Our base for this creative writing retreat is the Tower Guesthouse and as there are just 8 rooms, we will have the entire hotel to ourselves! Bedrooms have either Victorian or classic Chinese décor and all have writing desks and coffee-making facilities. A 'full English' or continental breakfast is included, and the breakfast room will also be the location for our writing workshops each morning. The Tower Guesthouse is an easy 10-minute stroll from the centre of the city, or if you prefer, a bus leaves from directly outside, every 15 minutes.

All rooms have a double or queen-sized bed with en suite facilities (some with showers, some with baths). One room has easy ground floor access for a writer with mobility challenges, and another has two single beds, making it ideal for writers who would



like to share, to reduce costs. Just enquire about this option when you book your space.

How to Find our Retreat

Our retreat in York begins at 5:00 PM on the first day, in the breakfast room at The Tower Guesthouse. Writers should aim to arrive before that time and settle in. After our introductory meeting, we will head into York for our welcome dinner.

York is located on the direct train line from Kings Cross Station in London (2.5 hours) and Manchester International Airport in the north (under 2 hours). The UK rail network is inexpensive, trains are clean and reliable, and tickets can easily be booked before you leave, at <u>www.thetrainline.com</u>

You can easily combine our retreat with an extended stay in England – perhaps to spend a few days in London. We're also happy to connect writers who may wish to travel elsewhere with a friend, after the retreat. From York's famous reilway station, a taxi to the days of our

retreat. From York's famous railway station, a taxi to the door of our guesthouse costs about five pounds.

If there are enough writers arriving into Manchester Airport before 1pm on the first day of our retreat, it may be cost effective to take a taxi, with the cost shared between participants.

Creative Writing Workshops


We will meet for 3 hours each morning (2 hours on the trip days). My workshops will include a wealth of writing techniques, varied prompts and an opportunity to share your work for feedback, should to choose to do so. In addition, we will take inspiration from York's turbulent and exciting past, so there will be a historical fiction aspect to this retreat! Beginning and experienced writers of fiction, poetry and memoir will find something in this week to help develop their skills and inspire further writing. Our content is always new, so this retreat is appropriate for writers who have already participated in our Costa Rica or Mexico writing trips.

Throughout the week, we may choose to write in evocative locations around York, and on the final evening, we'll share our work with one another in a final celebration.

One of these novels – The Promise She Made – is set partly in York. Julie's previous publications include a young adult novel and a poetry collection, each published by independent presses, and a book for teachers on how to make Shakespeare exciting for kids. She has also published widely in literary journals in Canada and the UK.

Julie has an MA in Literature from Warwick University in England and an MFA in Creative Writing from the University of British Columbia, Canada. She has been teaching creative writing on retreats and for her Torontobased arts company - Centauri Arts – for the past 20 years. Julie runs arts workshops for schools all over Canada, and was previously the ownerdirector of an overnight arts summer camp. She grew up an hour away from York.

Prices

Fee 1 - Deposit Payable on Registration

This fee is payable to Centauri Arts in Canadian funds at the time of booking. The fee secures your space on the trip, and covers the writing workshops and group services provided by us

Deposit per writer, per week \$750CDN (approx. \$525 US)

This fee includes: 5 writing workshops (approximate contact time - 15 hours), a manual of writing prompts and techniques, writing-related activities, group leader services, and a trip manual.

Non-writer, same room: \$150CDN (approx. \$100US)

(Includes group leader support only/social activities only)

Fee 2 – Lodge Fee, Payable 90 days Before Our Trip

This fee is payable directly to our hotel in York.

Cost per room (single occupancy), 6 nights, 660 GBP

(exchange rates fluctuate, go to https://www.xe.com/currencyconverter/ to check conversion rates.)

All rooms have en suite facilities and Wifi. One room offers 2 single beds, allowing 2 writers to share. Other rooms have double/queen beds and writers may choose to bring a spouse. This retreat is not suitable for children.

The fee quoted also includes a full English (or continental) breakfast daily per room. Where there are 2 occupants to a room, a small additional fee may apply.

Additional Services & Fees

This is not a package tour and Centauri Arts is selling the creative writing portion of the trip only. Writers are responsible for all additional costs on arrival, including transfers to the hotel, meals and sightseeing.


Lunches, dinners and beverages can be purchased from numerous pubs, restaurants, bakeries and cafes in York; allow about 25-30 pounds per day.

Our fees do not include your flight to Manchester or London, nor medical insurance.

Booking Terms & Conditions (The Small Print!)

Your electronic signature on the Application Form designates you accept and are willing to be bound by the following terms and conditions for the York Retreat offered by Centauri Summer Camp Inc. (hereafter referred to as "Centauri")

Payment

A deposit is required at the time of booking, payable to Centauri and covering the writing services we offer. If you must cancel your trip up to 12 weeks before your retreat, we will

refund your deposit/writing retreat fee, minus a \$350CDN cancellation fee. If you cancel within 12 weeks of your trip, no refund can be offered.

Flights

The flight is not included; this is not a package tour and participants join us from all over the world. York is located on the direct train line from Kings Cross Station in London (2.5 hours) and Manchester International Airport in the north (under 2 hours). The UK rail network is inexpensive, trains are clean and reliable, and tickets can easily be booked before you leave, at <u>www.thetrainline.com</u>

Writers are asked to notify us of their arrival and departure information 14 days prior to the retreat so we can connect writers arriving/departing at the same time.

In the event of delayed or cancelled flights, neither Centauri nor The Tower House can accept responsibility for financial losses incurred, and refunds cannot be offered for our writing workshops, nor their accommodation. A minimum of four writers is required to run each retreat. While we have always had more than 4 writers on all previous retreats, please ensure you check with us about the status of the retreat before booking your fights! In the event the retreat cannot operate, all monies paid to us will be refunded in full, but our liability shall then cease.

Cancellation

We cannot reimburse travel costs nor accept financial liability for losses incurred by you in the event of cancellation either by us or you for any reason whatsoever. You are strongly advised to take out insurance to cover potential loss (such as flight costs) arising from cancellation or any other eventuality affecting your booking, including COVID-19. In the unlikely event that we must cancel this trip for any reason - including safety concerns related to COVID 19 – all participants will be offered a full refund of their deposit.
